Saint Mary's East Update on Initial Universal Testing Results for COVID-19

Two Residents Test Positive, Weekly Testing to Continue

June 26, 2020 – Erie, PA – On June 22nd and 23rd, Saint Mary's East conducted COVID-19 testing of all residents and employees at the East campus. Nearly 400 individuals were tested, including approximately 250 employees and 147 residents. As of this morning, we are still awaiting the results of approximately 40 tests. Two residents have tested positive as a result of the mass testing. Both residents were asymptomatic and have been transferred to our isolated COVID-19 unit where they are resting comfortably and will continue to receive care. These are the first known cases of COVID-19 among residents at Saint Mary's East. Saint Mary's East is required to continue weekly testing of all residents and employees until testing identifies no new cases.

At this time, Saint Mary's East is reporting three active cases of COVID-19. Two cases are among residents, as reported above. One case is of an employee previously reported on June 10th who has since been isolated at home.

Saint Mary's at Asbury Ridge has reported zero cases of COVID-19 among staff and residents. Universal testing at Saint Mary's at Asbury Ridge will take place at a later date.

Our highest priority continues to be the health and safety of the residents we serve and the employees who care for them. Updates about our response to COVID-19 and the case status in our facilities are being shared at www.stmaryshome.org.
