

## Two Employees Test Positive for COVID-19 at Saint Mary's East

**July 13, 2020 – Erie, PA** – On July 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>, Saint Mary's East learned that two employees tested positive for COVID-19. The employees were tested during the third wave of mass testing held at the East campus on July 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>. Both employees are now quarantined at home. Due to these positive test results, mass testing will continue weekly for an additional 14 days until no new cases are identified. Weekly testing of nearly 400 individuals at the East campus has been ongoing since June 22<sup>nd</sup>.

At this time, the two employee cases reported above are the only active cases of COVID-19 at Saint Mary's East. Saint Mary's East previously reported two positive cases among residents who have since recovered.

Saint Mary's at Asbury Ridge has reported zero cases of COVID-19 among employees and residents. Universal testing of all residents and employees at Saint Mary's at Asbury Ridge will begin on July 13<sup>th</sup>.
