## Resident Tests Positive for COVID-19 at Saint Mary's East

**July 17, 2020 – Erie, PA** – On July 17<sup>th</sup> Saint Mary's East learned that a resident tested positive for COVID-19 during the fourth wave of mass testing held on July 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>. The resident was transferred to an isolated COVID-19 unit where they are resting comfortably. This is the third resident to test positive at Saint Mary's East. The two residents who previously tested positive have recovered.

At this time, there are three active cases of COVID-19 at Saint Mary's East. In addition to the single resident reported above, Saint Mary's reported last week that two employees tested positive during the third wave of testing. The employees are quarantined at home.

Saint Mary's at Asbury Ridge currently has zero cases of COVID-19 among employees and residents. Saint Mary's at Asbury Ridge completed their initial wave of mass testing on July 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup>.

Both campuses are still waiting to receive all of the results back from their most recent wave of testing.
