Saint Mary's & COVID-19: Update #45

Good Afternoon,

Saint Mary's at Asbury Ridge identified four new cases of COVID-19 earlier this week. Of those cases, three (3) were residents and one (1) was an employee. These cases were located in the Memory Care unit and a red zone has been established within that unit to further isolate the residents who tested positive. Families of those involved have been notified.

As a result, Saint Mary's at Asbury Ridge has reverted back to prior restrictions meaning that we cannot hold group activities or communal dining. If after a 14-day period of no new cases, Asbury Ridge can re-enter step two.

Saint Mary's East found no new cases of COVID-19 among residents or employees this week. East will re-enter step two and can resume some of the smaller group activities and communal dining practices. If after another 14-day period of no new cases, East can advance to step three.

Visitation and outings will remain cancelled until further notice at both campuses due to the Erie County positivity rate. We will continue to test two times a week.

Both East and Asbury Ridge have now held two vaccination clinics, meaning that a number of individuals have received both their first and second dose. Each campus will host a third clinic in February to give second doses to those remaining. We are grateful to Walgreens for their assistance in helping to protect our residents and employees. The clinics ran very smoothly and we are proud to have been among the first to get vaccinated in our area. Each person who was vaccinated received a COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card. Saint Mary's is keeping a copy of this card in the file of each resident but the original cards will be mailed to the residents POA/responsible party.
