### **Saint Mary's & COVID-19: Update #3**

We continue to make every effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19. At this time, there are no known cases of the virus within our facility. Earlier today you may have received a recorded message from our President/CEO. We are taking some additional steps in our prevention efforts. These steps include:

**Employee Face Masks:** Effective April 6th, all employees will be provided with a face mask and will be required to wear the mask at all times when working. This is to help prevent the unknown spread of the virus and to protect vulnerable residents and caregivers from unknown exposure.

**Easter Baskets and Gifts:** We request that families and friends do not drop-off Easter baskets and gifts for loved ones. We are happy to accept items sent through the USPS Mail, FedEx or UPS. We are accepting florist deliveries, both local and through the mail system.

**No Window Visitations:** Effective immediately, families and friends will not be permitted to visit at resident windows. We have received reports of individuals attempting to remove screens and standing outside and looking through the wrong windows. This creates a huge security and privacy risk that we must address. If you need help communicating with your loved one, let us know and we can work together on a solution.
