Saint Mary's & COVID-19: Update #57

Good Afternoon!

Another week of zero (0) cases of COVID-19 among our residents and employees.

At Saint Mary's East, we were notified earlier this week that an outside vendor who had contact with a number of residents tested positive. We worked quickly to identify which residents were exposed and isolated those residents to yellow zones. These residents are being tested regularly for a 14-day period to ensure their exposure does not convert to a positive case. Employees continue to be tested weekly. Residents in yellow zones are not permitted visitors at this time, but visitation can and has continued for other unaffected residents in green zones.

The positivity rate continues to tick up slightly in Erie County as it does elsewhere – this week we were at 6.4%. We continue to encourage everyone to get vaccinated and to follow safety precautions like wearing a facemask, washing your hands frequently, and practicing social distancing.

As you are aware, Saint Mary's has been holding small-scale vaccination clinics at our campuses for residents and employees. We have been informed that we will likely be able to expand these clinics to family members and close friends of our residents and employees. If this becomes a reality, we will share the details with you so that you may make plans to attend if you have not yet had an opportunity to be vaccinated!
